#### A Word from Your Teacher...

The weather outside may be frightful, but inside Room 115, the atmosphere is sure delightful! Students are doing a wonderful job of cooperatively working with each other on various projects and assignments in class.

The past month in class, 6<sup>th</sup> graders have been working diligently on their World Cultures Fair project. The purpose of the assignment was to not only learn strong researching strategies and work collaboratively in a group, but it was to also teach students about the importance of their assigned country before becoming the country's Model UN delegate. In the future, students will be speaking on behalf of the country to discuss issues that the country is facing and to problem-solve.

Further, students have been working hard to write their narrative about the idea of belonging/fitting in. Students brainstormed by generating various ideas of when he/she fit in or did not fit in. Then, they outlined the narrative by creating a theme for their written piece. Finally, they drafted and revised using grammar skills (clauses and sentence structure) and writing strategies (dialogue, inner thinking, and figurative language) that were taught throughout the unit. I hope they took the time to share their first writer's workshop piece with you!

As we move into the new trimester, 6th graders will be discussing various genres to begin organizing our classroom library.

Students will also engage in an independent reading project, where they will have a choice of different ways to showcase the novels they read to their peers this first trimester.

As if the trimester isn't busy enough, students are still working toward their IR goal. They will create new goals before winter break. It is my goal to encourage students to read for pleasure outside of school and to challenge them to be lifelong learners.
